OT- Technique Re-Orientation workshop



Operation Theatre (OT) is a department of the hospital where wonders happen. However, to make such wonders, one must make sure to follow the right procedure and guidelines learnt during his academic training. An OT team comprises of surgeons, anesthetists, scrub nurse, circulating nurse, assisting surgeons, OT technicians and other assisting paramedical staff. The essential role of an Operation Theatre Technician is to prepare the operating room for surgery and assist the surgeon during surgery. They are solely responsible for setting of the instrument trolleys, positioning the operation table and patient. With the increase in demand of healthcare professionals across the world, a Two-Days workshop on OT- Technique Re-Orientation Course was organized by Orthopedic Research & education Foundation-India under the auspices of World Orthopedic Concern & International Centre for Science and Society, Indore (Buti Foundation) On 26th and 27th March 2022 in Super Specialty Hospital auditorium. Hon'ble Founder Director Dr DK Taneja was the course, Director. It was a two-day reorientation program including basic operating room etiquette and describe different OT technique, instruments used in and Waste management.
